




The Mausoleum of the First Qin Emperor Museum

An eternal army guarding China's first emperor

- The Emperor Qinshihuang's Mausoleum Site Museum houses more than 8,000 terracotta warriors dating back to the 3rd century BCE. These magnificent clay figures guard the tomb of Emperor Qin Shi Huang, and the site has been a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1987.



Xi'an Ancient City Wall

Feel the pulse of a thousand years beneath your feet

- The Xi'an Ancient City Wall is the largest and best-preserved ancient city wall in China. First constructed in the 14th century during the Ming Dynasty, it remains a powerful symbol of the city's rich historical heritage. Encircling the old town in a 13.7-kilometer rectangle, the wall uniquely combines ancient military architecture with sweeping views of modern Xi'an.

Great Tang Ever-Bright City

A dazzling night that never sleeps

- The Great Tang Ever-Bright City is a lively pedestrian thoroughfare extending from the Giant Wild Goose Pagoda to the Tang Dynasty Theme Square. Filled with Tang-style architecture, immersive light shows, street performers and public art installations, it vividly recreates the charm and spirit of the Tang Dynasty.



Giant Wild Goose Pagoda

A timeless symbol of faith and learning

- The Giant Wild Goose Pagoda is a unique symbol of Xi'an with deep historical and cultural importance. Built in the Tang Dynasty over 1,300 years ago, its classic, solid brick structure has stood intact for centuries, combining religious significance, architectural value, and historical legacy.

City Tours



Shaanxi Archaeological Museum

Discover 5,000 years of Chinese history here

- As China's first archaeological-themed museum, Shaanxi Archaeological Museum opened in Xi'an in 2022. Designed in elegant Tang-style architecture, it houses over 200,000 artifacts spanning from the Paleolithic Age to modern times. More than 90% of the 5,215 displayed relics are shown to the public for the first time, including treasures from major sites like the Terracotta Army and Famen Temple.

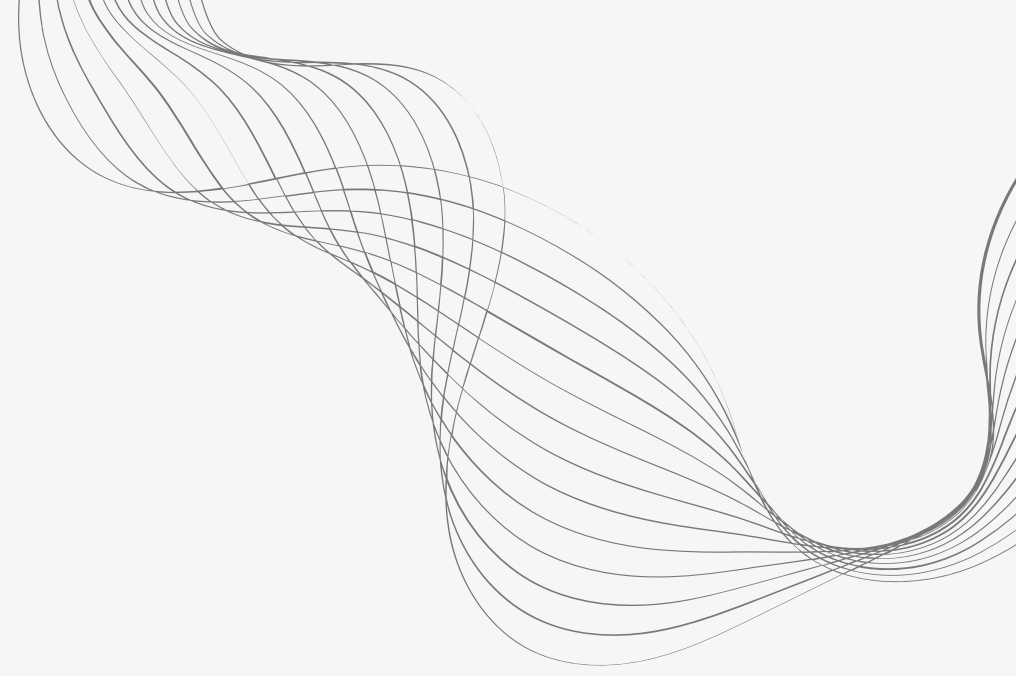


Highway Transportation Museum

Witness great achievements in infrastructure

- It spans 6,600m² across three floors with three core halls: Highway, Automotive, and Intelligent Transportation & Engineering Machinery. It showcases over 500 artifacts, including the iconic Hongqi CA770 sedan, scale models of the Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge, and vintage road-building equipment.

Must Try Foods



Roujiamo (Meat Burger)

Roujiamo is one of the most famous street foods in Xi'an and is also known as China's version of the hamburger. It's usually filled with diced pork tossed with green peppers and coriander before being stuffed to fill crispy oven-baked buns.



Yangrou Paomo (Pita Bread Soaked in Lamb Soup)

Yangrou paomo, or pita bread soaked in lamb soup, is another signature food of Xi'an. The main ingredient in this mouth-watering dish is mutton and pita bread. The hard bread is shredded and added to a bowl, then topped with stewed and sliced mutton, scallion, coriander and chili, then the soup is poured over all of it.



Biangbiang Noodles (Stewed-pork Hand-ripped Noodles)

Biangbiang noodles are thick, fat and long. Each belt-like strand is three fingers wide, spiraling down into a big bowl. It is served dry, with toppings of chili and pork belly in alternating layers of fatty and lean meat.



Must Try Foods

Liangpi (Cold Noodles)

Liangpi are cold noodles made from wheat or rice flour, and a popular dish in many other places in China, especially in summer. It looks translucent and tastes cold, and is known for its white color, thin shape, smooth surface, pliable texture and tender and savory taste.



Hulu Chicken (Gourd-shaped Chicken)

Huluji, gourd-shaped chicken, is boiled and deep-fried until tender. After being carefully selected, the hen will be boiled, steamed and fried in a gourd-shape, hence its name. The chicken has golden and crisp skin as well as fresh and tender meat.



Zeng Cake

Zeng cake is a traditional snack in Xi'an. To make it, sticky rice, red dates or honey dates are steamed on the iron zeng (an iron cooker) sometimes with red beans and raisins.
